Argentina

Luca, Old Vine, Valle Uco Mendoza Malbec

2022 | \$70

Lots of herbs mussel shells and sour black cherries. Full, fleshy and fresh on the palate with fine, silty tannins and a juicy, rather minerally finish. Long and tight but caressing and pretty transparent and tactile on the palate.

Australia

Prisoner wine company "Saldo", Barossa Shiraz

2021 | \$88

Aromas of vanilla, cracked pepper and a surprising touch of smoky bacon. It delivers dark cherries, bittersweet chocolate and clove on the palate with a muscular structure. Well integrated oak with a prolonged finish.

SPARKLING

Gramona Corpinnat Brut La Cuvée Aliances Méthode Tradicional Xarel-lo, Macabeu, Parelada, Chardonnay

2021 | \$75

Silky, seamless and dry. Offering intense Meyer lemon and intriguingly delicate pear flavors. Pure and Sharply focused, with outstanding finishing clarity and a stony persistence. This graceful, finely balanced Cava delivers outstanding value and competes favorably with plenty of Champagnes that sell for twice as much, if not more.

WHITES

Baskoli, Getariako Txakolina Hondarrabi Zuri

2023 | \$75

Clean and bright tropical fruit with a subtle effervescence of natural Carbon dioxide, giving this the perfect combination of acidity and fruit with a zesty refreshing zing!

Pentecostes, Rias Baixas Albariño

2023 | \$65

Notes of pear and apricot on the nose with a hint of sage brush and ocean air. It keeps some of those promises on the palate. The pear is tart and unripe. Silky texture with a slight oiliness. That's when the brine peeks out-a very mellow green olive. The fruit evaporates suddenly, leaving a lingering lemony flavor. It shifts into limestone and slate and finish with a return to the ocean air. There's a lot going on with this lovely Albariño!

REDS

Ramirez De La Piscina, Crianza, Rioja Tempranillo

2019 | \$60

A juicy and berry-oriented rioja with a stony edge to the black cherries and plums. Firm, bright and pretty succulent on the palate with medium body. Well-balanced even though it is not complex.

Viscarrá Senda Del Oro, Ribera del Duero Tempranillo

2022 | \$75

Aromatically this wine has ripe and juicy cherries, a hint of blackberry syrup and wet top soil. On the palate the wine is lush, with fruit focused flavors balanced out by crunchy green tannins and a satisfying herbaceous character on the back palate.

**Alvaro Palacios 2023 'Camins del Priorat' Priorat DOCa
Garnacha/Cariñena/Cabernet Sauvignon/ Syrah...**

2023 | \$77

Racy red bramble berries with notes of hibiscus, pomegranates, cochineal and cherries. Some chewy tannins add more gravity to the otherwise medium-bodied palate. Juicy, firm and stony in the medium-long finish

**Marques de Riscal XR Reserva, Rioja, Spain
96%Tempranillo 4% Graciano**

2021 | \$110

One of the most prestigious houses in Spanish wine making; this Medium- to full-bodied, elegant Rioja has those traditional baking spices people have come to associate with the region with ripe fruit and dusty tannins followed by a very lengthy finish. A winemaker's selection of special barrels marked 'XR'.

France

SPARKLING

**R.H. Coutier, Grand Cru Cuvee Tradition A Ambonnay, Champagne
20% Chardonnay, 80% Pinot Noir**

NV | \$120

An excellent and racy bottle with the signature red fruit characteristics of Ambonnay. Aromatically expressive, powerful on the palate, with a bright and fresh finish.

WHITES

**Domaine Roger & Christophe Moreux Tradition Sancerre, Loire
Sauvignon Blanc**

2024 | \$91

In return to a more classic style of Sancerre, the exceptional Domaine Moreux Tradition exhibits Sancerre's telltale pale yellow color, striking aromatics, and ripe passion fruit and melon flavors infused with the appellation's mouthwatering mineral rich acidity.

**Domaine Giles "La Collogne" Noblet Pouilly-Fuissé, Burgundy
Chardonnay**

2023 | \$100

A brilliant wine with notes of pear, honey and acacia blossom. Gentle oak presence rounds out the rich Chardonnay flavors giving it fine balance of fruit and freshness.

ROSE

**Domaine Les Mesclances "Charmes" Provence
Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah, Tibouren**

2024 | \$70

Opens with a salty mineral nose touched by dried leaves and soft florals. Notes of white peach, wild strawberry and citrus zest. It carries a vibrant acidity that keeps everything lifted, with subtle earthy depth that adds balance.

REDS

**Domaine Gille Grandes Creusottes, Cote d'Or, Burgundy
Pinot Noir**

2022 | \$98

Ruby with bright glints. Red berries and hints of blackcurrant on the nose. Well-balanced, fresh and fruity with soft tannins and lingering notes of vanilla on the finish. Perfect with BBQ, grilled beef and white meat.

**Domaine Gille "Les Brûlées" Nuits-St-Georges, Burgundy
Pinot Noir**

2022 | \$150

All the work is done by hand, following traditional methods, as M. Gille says "respecting the terroir and the unique character and challenges of each vintage." Les Brûlées is a south-east facing Lieu-dit in central Nuits-Saint-George. Named for the controlled-burn used to clear the land for agriculture. A true show-stopper of a Pinot Noir. Full and Lush: red berries with hints of blackcurrant. Powerful and structured on the palate with a long velvety finish. "Wow"

Domaine Chamfort Vacqueyras, La Perdriere Sablet Rhone Valley **2022 | \$82**
Grenache/Syrah/Mourvèdre (GSM)

Juicy notes of ripe red fruits, such as black cherry, raspberry, and plum, dominate, mingling with fragrant scents of earthy garrigue—a hallmark of the southern Rhône—evoking thyme, rosemary, and lavender. Subtle hints of dried herbs de Provence, freshly cracked pepper, and a touch of forest floor lend a savory complexity, while whispers of crushed violets and smoky minerality add further intrigue.

(Chateau de) St. Cosme Saint-Joseph, Rhone **2023 | \$110**
GSM

A sturdy, dark version, with earthy underpinnings of brown bread, olive tapenade, dusty earth and sandalwood smoke layered with macerated plum, dried lavender and bacon fat. Structured and well-framed, with juniper, herbs and grilled anise streaming through the substantial finish, where fine yet present tannins hold firm. This will unfurl with time. Drink now through 2033. 250 cases imported.

Chateau du Grand Soussans "Cru Bourgeois" Margaux, Bordeaux~Left Bank **2020 | \$130**
60% Cabernet Sauvignon 40% Merlot

A classic Margaux wine of great balance and finesse, the very characteristics that have made wines from this region among the most sought-after the world over. Highly aromatic, this Cabernet dominated blend offers a perfume of dark fruit aromas-berries, black currants -leading to delicate, ripe flavors with a long refined finish. The "Cru Bourgeois" classification signifies a wine of exceptional quality and authenticity.

Chateau Louvie Saint-Émilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux~Right Bank **2022 | \$75**
85% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc

A mere 1,000 cases produced from vineyards on the gentle clay and limestone soils of the 'right bank', Merlot and Cab Franc combine for a bright, ruby color. Fresh and baked black currant nose, Ripe cassis with mocha combine for smooth and lush textures. Well-balanced and stylish.

USA

Adelsheim "Breaking Ground", Chehalem Mtns, Willamette Valley, OR **2021 | \$100**
Pinot Noir

"The wine's earthy aromas of loam and wild mushrooms are joined by a sweet blackberry and lilac note that is perfume-like. Vigorous acidity and silky tannins back flavors of tangy red raspberries, cacao nibs and a trace of spicy Ligurian olive oil. Such a lively Pinot Noir."

Crossbarn, Sonoma Coast **2022 | \$89**
Pinot Noir

Made entirely with estate fruit, calls you into the glass with perfumed cranberry and pomegranate, accents of sweet baking spices, autumn leaves and a generous floral tones.

Canepa Koch Wine Cellars "The Dude" **2022 | \$57**
Pinot Noir

From the man who brought you prisoner, this Pinot Noir possesses deep aromas of wild strawberries and ripe raspberries accentuated with exotic notes of sandalwood and rose petal. Rich and luscious palate it is focused with layers of ripe red fruits, fresh forest floor and fine-grained tannins that linger through the finish.

Novelty Hill, Columbia Valley, WA **2022 | \$62**
Syrah

Balanced and expressive, with lively layers of dark plum, fresh blackberry and bold cherry aromas and flavors complemented by an appealing hint of exotic spice. The fruit gains focus on the palate, with refined tannins paving the way to a generous finish.

L'École No. 41, Columbia Valley, WA **2022**
Merlot

An aroma of black cherry juice washing over slate is accented by a hint of vanilla. The wine's flavors are equally rich, with a blackberry jelly note bumping up against bits of cedar and fresh-pulled espresso shots.

Bedrock, Sonoma County, California**2022 | \$80****Cabernet Sauvignon**

A flavor profile that includes blackcurrant, blueberry, violet, juniper, and Thyme. Nice juicy acidity and soft tannins.

Frank Family Vineyards Napa Valley, California**2023 | \$122****86% Cabernet Sauvignon 8% Merlot 6% Petit Verdot**

An elevated Napa Cabernet with inviting cassis, tobacco, and cocoa aromas. On the palate, gorgeous depth and complexity shine with hints of toasted oak. The tannins are finely ground and sweet, providing an elegant and expressive finish.

Pine Ridge, Napa Valley, CA**2023 | \$110****Cabernet Sauvignon**

This is Pine Ridge's flagship wine - a workhorse that sees both French and American oak. Tannins are teeth-kissing versus teeth-grabbing, while power and concentration are exhibited through a satin-lined mouthfeel that's also juicy and fresh, with dark chocolate, plum, graphite, and sweet soil. The fruit shows balance between depth and restraint

Robert Mondavi Winery, Napa Valley, California**2021 | \$140****Cabernet Sauvignon**

Soft around the edges and firm in the middle, this red-and black-fruited wine has a creaminess on the palate, delivering a mix of red cherries, blackberries and blueberries wrapped in moderate tannins. Contains small amounts of petit verdot, cabernet franc, malbec and merlot.

Italia

SPARKLING**Marsuet, Prosecco Treviso Extra Dry****NV \$45****Glera****Paltrinieri 'Solco' Semi-secco Frizzante Dell'Emilia IGT****2024 | \$45****Lambrusco**

This sparkling red is lifted and pretty, this Lambrusco exudes a bouquet of vibrant purple and blue flowers, such as violets and lavender. Wild plums and sour cherries seem to have been steeped in a bowl of wild mint and thyme, intriguing hints of mushroom and freshly turned earth adding depth to the aromatic profile. Delightful sweetness that lingers, lifted by an energetic pop of acidity. Perfect summer wine to pair with BBQ.

WHITES**Riva De La Rosa, Toscana****2024 | \$65****Vermentino**

Expressive fruit but mineral-driven. Bright acidity with notes of citrus and green apple. Very approachable white for those sauvignon blanc lovers looking to go off the beaten path.

Suavia, Soave Monte Carbonare**2022 | \$75****Garganega**

Bright straw yellow. Smoky and sulphurous, it has hints of flint together with notes of citrus and wildflowers. Creamy and elegant. It has great freshness and flavor. The finish is dry and very persistent.

REDS**Scaia Rosso Veneto IGT****2021 | \$60****Corvina**

Tart tangy punchy fruit up front. Floral, smoke, earth and savory notes follow on a long persistent finish. A lot packed into a small package with this light-medium bodied red.

Castello di Neive Barbaresco Piedmont, ITA**2021 | \$90****Nebbiolo**

As the wine opens, it reveals a garden full of ripe raspberries, rosebuds, thyme and black tea leaves. The elegance of this wine cannot be overstated. A finesse that showcases

Terre di Montalcino Brunello di Montalcino Tuscany**2020 | \$100****Sangiovese**

Velvety black cherry core with crunchy acidity framed by firm, dusty tannins. A Brunello that stands shoulder to shoulder with its storied siblings from the Siro Pacenti Estate in Tuscany.

Uccelliera, Rapace Toscana**2021 | \$85****Sangiovese, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon**

This Super Tuscan is predominately Sangiovese. The cabernet opens autumnal aromas of earth and dry leaves. This frames the black currant, sour plum and roasted bell pepper of the Merlot and Sangiovese.

Vietti Nebbiolo Langhe Perbacco DOC Piedmont**2022 | \$74****Nebbiolo**

Crushed flowers, red-toned fruit, mint give, white pepper and orange peel this rich, textured red notable aromatic brightness and presence. Ethereal yet structured and serious.

Boroli Barolo del Castiglione Falletto Piedmont, ITA**2019 | \$115**

This wine is an elegant, intense red, with mint and underbrush flavors augmenting the cherry and strawberry fruit. Fresh, elegant and well balanced.

Ελλάδα (Greece)

WHITES**Alpha Estate "Turtles" Vineyard****2024 | \$45****Malagouzia**

Yellow flowers and honey suckle, mellow herbal notes with a lingering finish.

REDS**Alpha Estate "Hedgehog" Vineyard****2023 | \$52****Xinomavro**

Bright, tart red berries against a backdrop of leather and baking spices squeezed into a light bodied presentation making it surprisingly complex for how quaffable it is.

Seméli Mountain Sun Peloponnese**2023 | \$45****Agiorgitiko/Syrah**

Crushed Vibrant ruby-violet color. Rich aromatic bouquet combining fresh cherry, plum, lively raspberry and blackberry fruits with a touch of spice on the nose. Balanced palate with round and velvety texture. Noble tannins and long aftertaste.
